

Wood procurement policy

Usine Sartigan is committed to purchase wood from well manage forest where harvest methods comply with the requirements of forest certification standards such as FSC, SFI or CSA-Z809, and to make sure that the wood is not produce from any of the following controversial sources:

- Forest harvested illegally
- Genetically modified trees
- Forests where high conservation values are threaten by management activities
- Wood harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights
- Wood from a forest being converted to plantations or non-forest use

To achieve this commitment, Usine Sartigan intends to comply with all legal and other requirements applicable to its wood procurement activity and undertakes to maintain necessary control measures to ensure its customers that the certified products it manufactures do not contain any wood from controversial sources.

Usine Sartigan also commits to continually improve its chain of custody for its wood fiber sourcing to ensure customers that their certified forest products are meeting the more stringent environmental requirements.
