
# Nishihirabatake Park

西平畑公園 / にしひらばたけ こうえん



This is a park from where you can see Mt. Fuji, the Ashigara plain and Sagami Bay.

You can find a number of recreational facilities here, such as the Herb Garden, a miniature train ride, the nature hall and a big slide on the slope, from which you can get a great view of the surrounding area on a clear day.


