## TREE CROSS ADVENTURE

Fun activities for families

Bouldering 12 meters up in the treetops

Tree Cross Adventure is a challenging adventure park taking advantage of an uneven topography. It consists of 6 courses with 42 obstacles, featuring a total of 550 meter zip-lines, bouldering and more. Some activities are as high as 15 meters up in the treetops and longest zip line is 173 meters flying over a 30 meter deep valley. Play duration: approximately 2 hours. there is also a Kids Athletics for children between 4-8 years. Rental wear available.

## NANASAWA FOREST PARK

A forested park of undulating grounds

This forest park of 65 hectares, situated at the base of Higashi-Tanzawa mountains, is one of the biggest forest park within the prefecture. There are various walking tracks within the park and they are perfect way to enjoy the sceneries four seasons offer. There is also a barbecuing area in which you can rent barbecue tools (reservations required). Mori no Atelier (Forest art studio) offers classes in pottery and raku-yaki (traditional Japanese pottery used for tea ceremonies) and more.

## KANEGATAKE HIKING COURSE

Kanegatake (561m)

Let's go for a hike!!

This mountain peak has been considered sacred and revered as "mountain god" and the remains of its sculptures and monuments can be found along what has now become a hiking course. Asama Shrine, a Shinto Shrine is located near the summit. Because the path is narrow, steep, and there are spots of slippery area, the course is recommended for more experienced hikers. It is approximately 8km long and takes about roughly 2 hrs and 25 mins to complete.

## OYAMA

Mt. Oyama (1252m) is a popular sightseeing spot of Kanagawa Prefecture. Visitors can take the cable car up to the Afuri Shrine which is located midway up the mountain. The fresh new leaves of spring and autumn colors draws many visitors to this site. The scenery you can enjoy from Afuri Shrine has been awarded 2-stars by the Michelin Green Guide. Other must-see sights in the area are the Oyama Temple and Hinata Yakushi Temple.



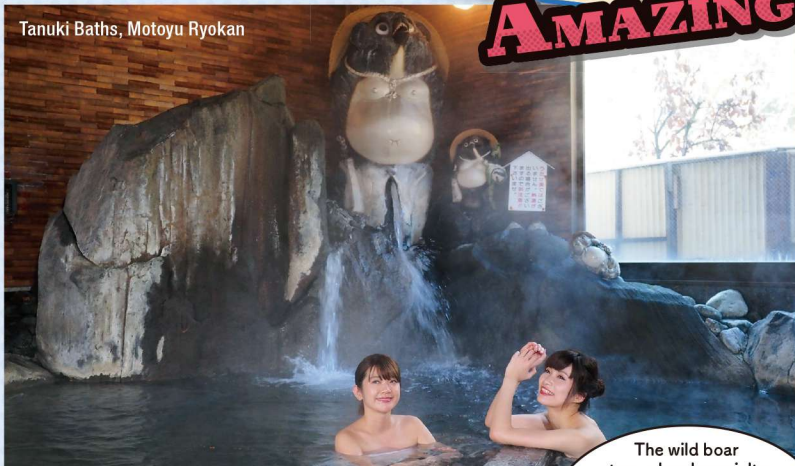
## MIYAGASE DAM

The Miyagase Dam is one of the largest dams in the Metropolitan area. Water is regularly released from the dam and it has become a popular tourist event. Approximately 30 m<sup>3</sup> of water gushes down the dam for about 6 mins. This 70m tall man-made waterfall about offers a magnificent view as it plashes fine mists that almost looks like smoke. The lakeside area is a fun place for the family as it is lined with restaurants, leisure boats, Aikawa Kangagawa Prefectural Park and more.



# Iiyama Hot Springs

There are many atmospheric hot springs along the Koayu River, on the east of the Higashi-Tanzawa mountains. The high level of alkaline in hot springs exfoliates your skin. You can enjoy the hot springs without saying overnight. This is also one of the best place to enjoy the cherry blossoms.

## ATSUGI MUSEUM

Enjoy displays of traditional local toys, and delicious cuisine.

This place is described as a "museum" hotel located in higher ground which offers panoramic view of Oyama and Tanzawa mountain ranges. Inside the museum, there are over 15,000 objects on display, including vintage toys, paintings, books, ceramics, and more. You can stay overnight, or simply take a daytrip to enjoy a meal of local specialties and/or hot springs.

## MOTOYU RYOKAN JAPANESE-STYLE INN

A Japanese ryokan with a truly traditional Japanese mood

This place has 26 rooms, baths, and dining area spread throughout its spacious ground that it feels as if you're staying in a castle town. Due to the high level of alkaline in the water, their hot springs are known to have beautifying affect. Some rooms come with private outdoor baths. Enjoy original banquet-style course prepared with local produce.

## Iiyama Hakuryu Drums

Powerful drumming and dance

The Iiyama Hakuryuudaiko (White Dragon Japanese drums) and White Dragon Dance derives from an ancient rain dance. Rapid beating of the drums and the dance of the 'dragon' represents the villagers praying for rain, and the white dragon that soars across the sky to bring rain. You can enjoy their performance at the annual Atsugi Iiyama Cherry Blossom Festivals.



## Iiyama Hakusan Forest Park

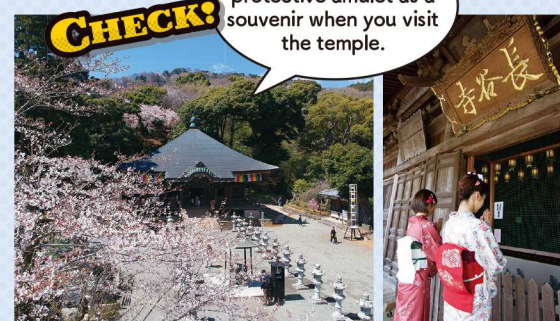
Stunning views throughout the four seasons

This nature park, located near the Iiyama Kannon, is a popular spot for hikers all around the year. The visitors especially enjoy the cherry blossoms in bloom from late March till early April, and the fall foliage from late November till early December.

## Iiyama Kannon Chokoku-ji Temple

Makes the list of the Prefecture's Top 50 Scenic Views

This historic temple comes alive with stunning cherry blossoms in the spring, hydrangea in early summer, and red maple leaves in the fall. The Kannon Hall which dates back to the 18th Century houses the famous Eleven-faced Kannon statue. The temple is also a go-to place to pray if you're in search for a partner. Souvenirs such as protection amulets and special red-ink stamps are also available.

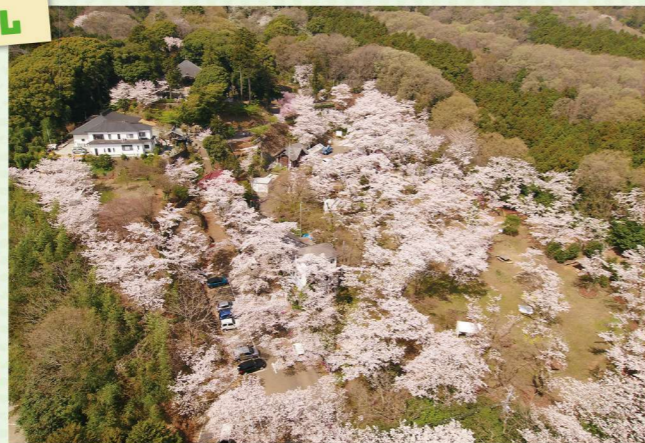

April

## ATSUGI IYAMA CHERRY BLOSSOM FESTIVAL

This is a major event held at the Iiyama Hakusan Park which is considered as one of the most famous cherry blossom viewing spot. Performances by the White Dragon drumming and dance, women carrying the *sakura mikoshi* (cherry blossom portable shrine), as well as the cherry blossoms in full bloom, attracts thousands of visitors to this festival.

## ATSUGI TSUTSUJI-NO-OKA PARK

Late April to early May

This is the largest field of azalea in the prefecture, where 52 thousand azalea bush thrive over the 17,000m<sup>2</sup> park. Towards the end of April, an azalea festival celebrating the blooming azalea takes place and you can enjoy pop-up events like small animal zoo and stamp rally throughout the park.

## ATSUGI AYU & FIREWORKS FESTIVAL

August

This is the biggest festival of the year in Atsugi and it takes place during the first weekend of August, Saturdays in particular is the highlight of the festival as more than 10 thousand fireworks light up the sky—making it the biggest fireworks festival within the prefecture. The bustling festival includes other entertainment such as sweet-fish grabbing event for little kids by the river, mikoshi parade, dance contest and more.

## ATSUGI FOLK MUSEUM



Priceless cultural assets on display—all worth seeing!

### Get to know the history of Atsugi

This full-scale canal replica on display here were reconstructed to the correct dimension calculated from the photographs of Higashi-cho taken by Italian-British photographer Felice Beato towards the end of the Edo Period (1603-1868). The puppets from Sagami puppet theatre as well as costumes from Sagami-sato Kagura (Sagami's sacred dance and music) are also on display, showcasing Atsugi's arts and culture.

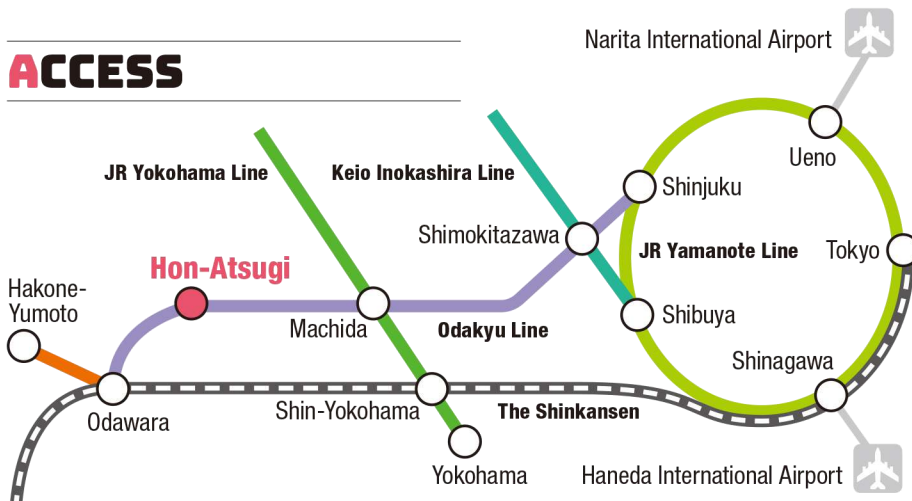
