



To submit your quilt(s) to be judged in our show, visit <u>mountainquiltfest.com</u> and click on <u>Guidelines for Quilt Show Entry</u>. These guidelines will describe the available categories for entry and provide you with an entry form for each of your submissions. There is NO LIMIT to the number of quilts that can be submitted. Please follow the instructions carefully. Quilts may be submitted in person during specified Quilt Take-In times or through the mail.

<u>Mailed</u> in entries must be postmarked by: Wednesday, May 4 UPS or USPS ONLY.

For those wishing to <u>hand delive</u>r their entries in person the dates are Friday, May 13, from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm or Saturday, May 14, from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm at the Pigeon Forge Office of Special Events, located at 3107 Parkway, Pigeon Forge. Please be aware there will most likely be heavy traffic in Pigeon Forge so please allow for plenty of time to arrive at the office within the designated time frame. *Additionally, quilts will not be accepted after 2:00 pm on Saturday, May 14.*



THEME QUILTS

2022 THEME QUILT: STRING TIME IN THE SMOKIES

String piecing is a patchwork quilt-making technique that is accomplished by sewing multiple fabrics together to create a "strip set" that looks like a portion of a quilt block. The strips can be any color combination, from scrappy to graduated color families. The strips do not need to be uniform width, and the strip set can be cut apart to yield segments that replace two or more pieces of fabric. The quilt must be an interpretation of string quilts and should be recognizable as a string quilt.

The category is split into large and small quilts. The category is split into large (250 inches or larger) and small (249 inches or less) quilts. These categories are exempt from the Quilted by Another restriction. Prizes will be awarded in both the Large and Small Theme Quilt categories.



2023 THEME QUILT: TWO BLOCK TANGO



This quilt requires two distinct blocks.

The blocks can be arranged in any manner and include any number of each block. Sashings, cornerstones and borders may be added and are exempt from the two block rule.

The category is split into large (250 inches or larger) and small (249 inches or less) quilts. These categories are exempt from the Quilted by Another restriction. Prizes will be awarded in both the Large and Small Theme Quilt categories.




QUILT APPRAISALS

Certified quilt appraiser, **Cynthia** (**Cindy**) **Stuart**, will again provide professional quilt appraisals for anyone wishing to have their quilts appraised. Quilt appraisals will be available by appointment only, on June 6-9, 2022.

Cindy is a quilt historian who began quilting in the 1990s and became interested in quilt restoration after repairing a wedding quilt for her mother. In order to restore quilts, one must learn how to date fabrics and use quilting techniques consistent with those used in the past.

All appraisals will be conducted in private at the LeConte Center at Pigeon Forge. Please inquire at the Information Desk when you arrive for directions to the appraisal room. If you have not made a prior appointment, but would like to see if Cindy can work you in, contact her directly at the number listed above.

The appraisal fee for **one quilt is \$50**, with each additional quilt appraised by **\$45 each**.



Verbal consultations are \$20/each.






