Interactive Tour "Samurai Walk"

"Hiyodori-zaka," where samurai once walked, is a prime photo spot!

Sakura City, the castle town of the Sakura domain during the Edo period (1603-1867), is a trove of castle ruins and former samurai residences. Held here is a walking tour in which you can explore the castle town as if you were a samurai of the past. Along with a tour that is available in English, you can also enjoy various experiences such as exploring the ruins and taking pictures in a samurai costume and practicing martial arts with a bamboo sword.

Early July

Narita Gion Festival

成田祇園祭

Around Naritasan Shinsho-ji Temple

Roughly 450,000 spectators come to enjoy this festival with over 300 years of history every year. It is a big summer event in which ten floats and stalls and one *mikoshi* shrine adorned with splendid sculptures and decorations are carried out for a three-day procession through Naritasan Omotesando Street and the surrounding area.

Sawara no Taisai Festival

Honjuku District (summer festival), Shinjuku District (autumn festival)

Boasting around 300 years of history, this festival is held bi-annually in July and October. Ten floats during the summer festival and 14 floats during the autumn festival pass through the traditional townscape, a magnificent sight to behold. Other main features include the float decorations and festival music "Sawara-Bayashi" that add color to the festivities.

The highlight is "Mobara Awa Odori," a dancing event that gathers together some 1,000 people.

Katsuura Big Hina Doll Festival

Mt. Nokogiri Hiking

鎌山ハイキング

At 329 meters high, Mt. Nokogiri first gained fame as a stone quarry during the Edo period (1603-1867). Even today, you can find exposed cliff faces and remnants of the stone quarry throughout the mountain. It is also a popular hiking course with many notable features. The north side offers both breathtaking and unusual views and vistas, while the south side is home to Nihonji Temple with its many stone Buddha statues.

To reach the summit, you can ride the Mt. Nokogiri Ropeway or go by car.

While hiking, you can see a stone Kannon statue approximately 30 meters tall, carved into the vertical wall of the quarry.



Another must-see is the 31-meter Buddha statue in Nihonji Temple carved directly into the rock, one of the biggest of its kind in Japan.

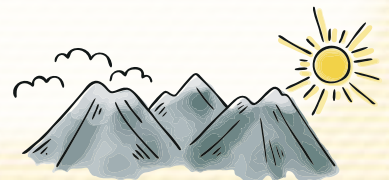

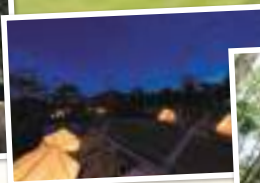

The Seafari Boat is useful for experiencing the vast nature that Katsuura boasts, from the spectacular bay, hidden coves, massive limestone cliffs, famous rock formations, to other impressive landmarks. If you're lucky, you might see black kites gliding through the sky, or sea turtles and other unusual marine animals popping their heads out of the sea. 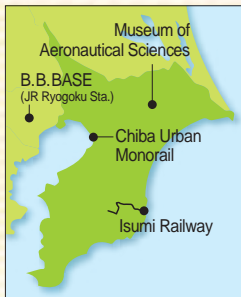


Museum of Aeronautical Sciences

Chiba Urban Monorail

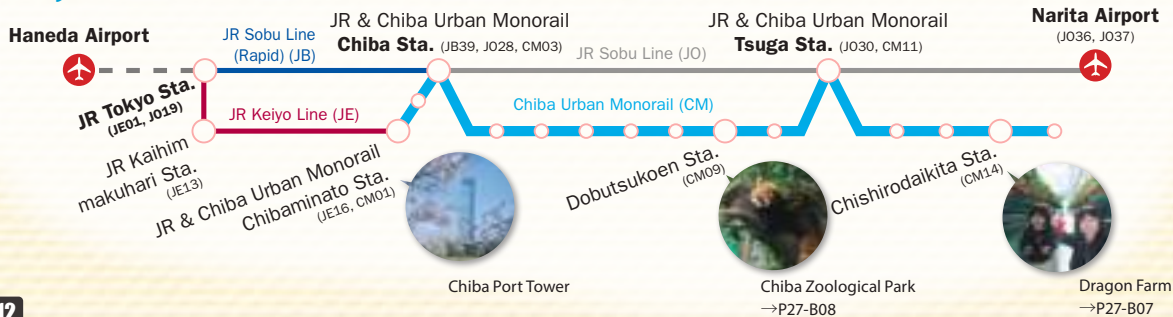

This two-line suspended monorail system is very rare in the world and makes you feel like you are on a flying train. It was recorded in the Guinness World Record for the world's longest running distance of suspended monorail (15.2 km of track) in 2001. The new train cars have an improved view with glass in part of the floor, making you feel like you are flying as well as being thrilled. Don't miss it if you are visiting the Bay area.

Isumi Railway is one of Chiba Prefecture's most famous local railways, stretching 26.8 km westward from Ohara Station on the southeast coast. It connects to Kominato Railway via Kazusa-Nakano Station, allowing visitors to use the two railways to travel across the Boso Peninsula. Along the railroad, you'll find an idyllic pastoral landscape that appears untouched by the hands of time. In particular, late March and early April offer the stunning springtime panorama of trains running through cherry blossoms and yellow "nanohana" flowers flanking the railroad. Don't forget to visit the area around Higashi-Fusamoto Station and Nishihata Station, a popular spot for cherry blossom viewing.

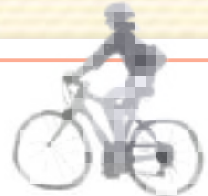

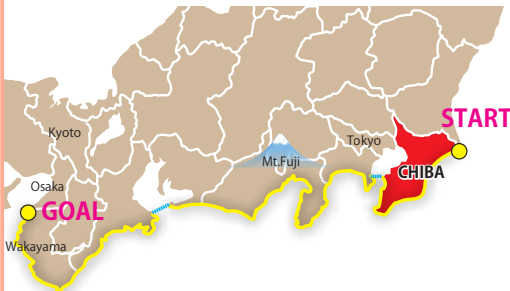

Pacific Cycling Road



In 2021, the "Pacific Cycling Road" that runs along the Pacific Coast was designated Japan's "National Cycling Route." It starts at Choshi Station, located in Choshi City at the eastern end of Chiba Prefecture. After circling roughly half of Chiba Prefecture (Boso Peninsula), the 1,487-kilometer course takes you on a ferry across a stretch of the ocean, passes through Kanagawa and Shizuoka prefectures, and finishes off at Wakayama Prefecture's Kada Port. Even just from the Choshi starting point to Hamakanaya, this invigorating course offers breathtaking views of the ocean and Mt. Fuji. Dare to take the challenge?



Bring your bicycle to **Boso!**



If you want to enjoy cycling around on your bicycle in Chiba, you should take "B.B.BASE," a special train for cyclists from Tokyo to Chiba. Leaving JR Ryogoku Station, this train stops at several stations all over Chiba. After enjoying cycling, take "B.B.BASE" again back to Tokyo in the evening. You can enjoy a carefree cycling tour in a day trip or an overnight trip.

At the bicycle station next to JR Ryogoku Station, a rental service of road bikes and cross bikes is available. So even if you don't have your own bicycle, you can rent a favorite bike and get on "B.B.BASE."

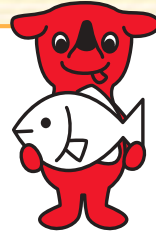




Exquisite Chiba cuisine

With Japanese pear cultivation starting here nearly 250 years ago, Chiba has now become the nation's biggest producer of the juicy, sweet fruit.



Melon / Watermelon

Chiba boasts the second largest crop of watermelons in Japan and the main producer is Tomisato City. Asahi City is the biggest producer of melons in Chiba Prefecture.



Loquat

In Japan, these biwa (loquats) known under the brand "Boshu Biwa" are popular gifts. You can eat them as they are, but loquat soft-serve ice cream is pure delight. You can also buy loquat jelly as a souvenir.

Places to enjoy various activities in Chiba

Animals



Chiba Prefecture has one of the major farms in Japan and one of the major aquariums in Japan, as well as the zoo with the greatest number of elephants in Japan and popular lesser pandas. The following section introduces 5 popular spots where you can enjoy touching animals.

Mother Farm

→ P50-S06

マザー牧場

Located on Mt. Kano, which offers a grand panoramic view of the mountains on Boso Peninsula, Tokyo Bay, and Mt. Fuji, Mother Farm is one of the biggest tourist ranches in the Kanto area. On the huge grounds of about 2.5 million square meters, seasonal flowers are beautifully blossoming and various animals, including alpacas, cows, sheep, horses, and goats, are available for visitors to play with and touch. There are lots of activities, including horse-back riding, zip line, bungee jumping, an amusement park, strawberry and blueberry picking, and hand-making experiences, providing an entertaining farm where both grownups and children can have fun.



Ichihara Elephant Kingdom

市原ぞうの国

Located roughly in the center of Chiba Prefecture, this zoo has 12 elephants, which is the greatest number in Japan, along with about 90 kinds of animals, including capybaras and hippos. The popular "Elephant Show," where elephants perform difficult tasks, such as playing soccer and dancing, is offered almost every day. There are also various attractions, such as "Elephant Riding," where you can get on the back of an elephant, "Elephant Lift," where you can hang down from the nose of an elephant, and photo taking with a small elephant.

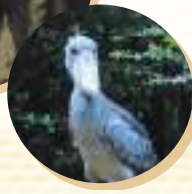
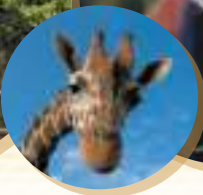

At “Keiyo Gakuin Lion School,” the only facility with lions, you can feel their power up close through the glass. The zoo is divided into several areas, including the “Steppe Zone,” the “Avian and Aquatic Zone,” and the “Monkey Zone.” “Fureai Dobutsu no Sato” offers a petting zoo area, and a horse-back riding corner, as well as a BBQ area, where you can enjoy grilling your meal with no advanced preparation needed.

Located in front of the Pacific Ocean, this is one of Japan’s biggest aquariums, based on the concept of “encountering the ocean world.” Through the exhibitions based on recreated natural environments, including a stellar attraction featuring killer whales, the king of the ocean, a stunning performance of bottlenose dolphins and Pacific white-sided dolphins, and impressive performances of belugas and seals, you can see 11,000 animals of 800 kinds living in rivers and oceans. At “Tropical Island” with replicas of tropical coral atolls, you can enjoy walking around as if you are a diver in the ocean.

Dolphin and Whale Watching at Choshi Ocean Institute

Roughly 20 species of wild dolphins and whales have been observed migrating off the coast of Choshi, where the Oyashio and Kuroshio currents flow. If you get on a boat and travel 30 km out to sea, you can get a glimpse of the dolphins and whales year-round. You might even encounter a pod of up to 2,000 dolphins!

With expansive grounds of 2.5 million square meters, this farm is home to various animals including cows, horses, sheep, and alpacas. It also hosts daily events and shows where visitors can interact with the animals. Popular events include the "Sheep Show" (sheep shearing) at Agrodome and "Cow Milking Experience." Also popular are the large-scale, picturesque flower gardens with canola flowers in spring as well as petunias, the "momoiro toiki" (pink breath) of summer. Additionally, you can enjoy various other activities including riding the Ferris wheel and bungee jumping from 21 meters high. The souvenir shops sell original Mother Farm sweets and homemade ham and sausages. Some popular park food includes their signature jingsukan mutton dishes and soft-serve ice cream. Mt. Nokogiri & Nihonji Temple / Nokogiriyama Ropeway

Mt. Nokogiri is a 329.4-meter-high mountain. The mountain consists of tuff that was suitable for construction and it used to be a quarry from the Edo period. The shape of the exposed mountain surface took on a saw-toothed shape, giving it a name of “Nokogiri,” which means “saw.” The view from “Jigoku-nozoki,” which is situated near the top of the mountain is both beautiful and thrilling. The slope on the south side of the mountain is the temple grounds. The temple, Nihonji was built by the Buddhist monk called Gyoki at the behest of Emperor Shomu about 1,300 years ago. You can visit the largest Buddha statue carved on a rock face with a height of 31 meters, Hyakushaku-Kannon statue, which might remind you of the Bamiyan Buddha and the 1,500 stone figures of Arhats. The ropeway in Mt. Nokogiri is the only ropeway in Chiba Prefecture.



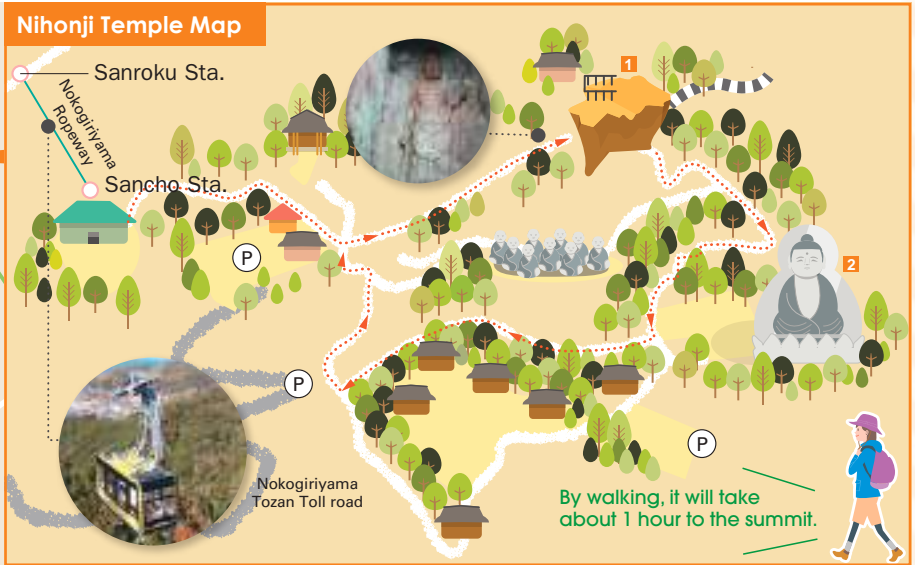

Highways

When driving on highways, having an "ETC card" will allow you to pass through the lane indicated "ETC" at the toll gates. "ETC" is an abbreviation for "Electronic Toll Collection System." With an ETC card inserted into the designated device in your car, the toll fee is automatically deducted, and you do not have to stop at the toll gate. On the other hand, if you do not have an ETC card, you must pay the fee by cash or credit card at the lane indicated with a green "General" sign. ETC cards can be rented from car rental companies (you will be charged with the highway fees when returning your car).
